Our program is "child-centered." Our classrooms are structured, and our days are filled with art projects, letters, storytelling, science, music and most importantly play. We have a nurturing, encouraging and play based learning environment in our preschool. We have a 5 Star Youngstar rating and exceptional Early Childhood Certified teachers.

We have enclosed information about our preschool as well as a registration form. If you are interested in enrolling your child in our program, please complete the registration form and return it along with the non-refundable registration fee of \$100. You will be notified via email once we have this information. If no openings are available at that time, you can be placed on our waiting list.

A co-operative preschool is administered and maintained by the parents on a non-profit, self-funded basis. Participation is essential in our success. We encourage you to take advantage of the wonderful opportunity to help in your child's classroom on his/her scheduled "special day". We encourage you to participate in our special events and to volunteer on the Board of Directors. We do require participation in a couple of areas in our preschool operation: to volunteer on at least one committee at the preschool (minimal time commitment; many committees have no meetings) and to participate in one scheduled Saturday or weeknight cleaning during the school year (with buyout option).

## **Menomonee Falls Preschool Co-op 2022 - 2023 Tuition and Fee Schedule**

### **Registration Fee**

Registration for 3K and 4K\* .....\$100 per child  
(Registration fee is non-refundable)

### **Annual Tuition**

**3K/2-day tuition**\* **\$1,420** if paid in full by August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, via check or cash  
9 installments of **\$160** paid via check or cash starting August 1<sup>st</sup>.

**4K/4-day tuition**\* **\$2,210** if paid in full by August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, via check or cash  
9 installments of **\$250** paid via check or cash starting August 1<sup>st</sup>.

\* Payments must be made on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, August through April. There will be a **\$25 late fee** charged if payment is received **after the 5<sup>th</sup> of each month**. *If payment plus late fee is not received by the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month your child will not be allowed to return to school until such payment is received.*

### **Cleaning Buyout Fee**

Optional Cleaning Buyout\* .....\$150

(You have the option to buy out of your required one-time preschool cleaning. Cleanings are every other month on a Saturday morning or a weekday evening. The scheduled cleaning time is 2-3 hours.)

**Lunch Bunch**\* .....\$10 per day

Extra time added to certain scheduled days so your child can have lunch with their friends and enjoy added activities under the supervision of one of our teachers and an aide. Begins at 12:00 pm. and ends at 1:00 pm. You supply your child's lunch.

\*The above fees are accurate until May 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023
