Our program is "child-centered." Our classrooms are structured, and our days are filled with art projects, letters, storytelling, science, music and most importantly play. We have a nurturing, encouraging and play-based learning environment in our preschool. We have a 5-Star YoungStar rating and exceptional Early Childhood Certified teachers.

We have enclosed information about our preschool as well as a registration form. You will be notified via email once we have this information. If no openings are available at that time, you can be placed on our waiting list.

We do require participation in a couple of areas in our preschool operation: to volunteer on at least one committee at the preschool (minimal time commitment; many committees have no meetings) and to participate in two scheduled Saturday or weeknight cleaning during the school year (with buyout option).

Co-operative preschools can provide quality preschool activities because of parent participation. As parents, we are the administrators, classroom assistants, and policy-makers in the program. Because we are all these things, the Co-op strongly encourages involvement and time from families.

Our parents are responsible for participating in the Menomonee Falls Preschool Co-operative in the following ways:

- Attend the Fall orientation event.
- Participate as a member of a committee with an assigned task and/or as member of the Board of Directors.
- Participation is encouraged for our main fundraisers: Support the Co-op!
- Some examples of fundraisers from previous years are:
 - Donations
 - Holiday Party attendance
 - "Dining Out" nights
 - Other fundraiser opportunities
- Participate in mandatory Saturday or weeknight cleaning during the school year. This is approximately a 2–3-hour commitment to be performed with other school families and can be a fun way to meet other parents while helping the preschool. Each family without a board member is required to attend two cleaning sessions each school year.
- Attend teacher conferences held each semester.
- Pay the tuition as outlined in the Tuition and Fee Schedule enclosed in this packet.

Registration Fee

Registration for 3K:..... \$100 per child (non-refundable) There is no separate registration fee for Hearts & Hands Playgroup. Playgroup registration can be found at tinyurl.com/MenFallsCoopPlay

Annual Tuition

3K: Check/Cash Rate	\$165/mo August - April (or \$1,465 paid in full)	
3K: Venmo Rate	\$168.30/mo August - April (or \$1,493 paid in full)	
Hearts & Hands Playgroup: Check/Cash Rate\$160/6-week session		
Hearts & Hands Playgroup: Venmo Rate\$163.20/6-week session		

Payments must be made on or before the 1st of each month, August through April. There will be a \$25 late fee charged if payment is received after the 5th of each month. If payment plus late fee is not received by the 15 of each month your child will not be allowed to return to school until such payment is received.

Cleaning Buyout Fee

Optional Cleaning Buyout\$150

(You have the option to buy out of your required two preschool cleanings. Cleanings are every other month on a Saturday morning or a weekday evening. The scheduled cleaning time is 2-3 hours.)

Lunch Bunch.....\$11 per day

Extra time added to certain scheduled days so your child can have lunch with their friends and enjoy added activities under the supervision of one of our teachers and an aide. Begins at 12:00 pm. and ends at 1:00 pm. You supply your child's lunch.
